He is regarded as one of the

alone wrote the first draft of The
Declaration of Independence.

Who is Thomas Jefferson?



This founding father was
President from 1797-1801.
He was the first vice president.
Nicknamed “Atlas of American
Independence”.

Who is John Adams?



This founding father was
President from 1809-1817.
He was a soft spoken man who
was about 5'4" and less than
100 pounds. He also helped
draft Virginia's state
constitution at age 25.

Who is James Madison?



This founding father's highest political office was Minister to France. He was one of the three Americans to sign the peace treaty with England that ended the Revolutionary War. He also made enough money from his publishing business to retire at age 42.

Who is Benjamin Franklin?



This Constitutional Amendment
allows Freedom of Religion,
Speech, and The Press; Rights of
Assembly and Petition

What is the First Amendment?



This Amendment provides rights
to a fair trial.

What is the sixth Amendment?



This Amendment abolished
slavery.

What is the thirteenth Amendment?



This Amendment gave women
the right to vote.

What is the nineteenth Amendment?



Only one amendment has overturned another amendment. The Twenty-First Amendment repealed the prohibition of alcohol that was established in this amendment.

What is the eighteenth Amendment?



In this year congress proposed
an amendment to making
marriage between races illegal.

What is 1912?



In this year congress proposed
an amendment that attempted
to limit personal wealth to \$1
million.

What is 1933?



In this year congress proposed
an amendment that would
rename this nation the “United
States of the Earth”.

What is 1893?



In this year congress proposed
an amendment that forbid
drunkenness in the United
States and all of its territories.

What is 1938?



In this year congress proposed
an amendment that American
citizens should have the
alienable right to an
environment free of pollution.

A formal change to the United States Constitution. Currently there are 27 of these.

What is an amendment?



The first ten amendments to the Constitution that were adopted in 1791. These are basic rights that all Americans have and its purpose is to protect people from the government.

What is The Bill of Rights?



The governmental philosophy in which the people ideally have a high degree of control over political leaders.
